

WHEELCHAIR BUS APPLICATION

Regulations: Anyone is eligible who requires a wheelchair for mobility outside his/her home, any client in Northview Nursing Home or Englehart and District Hospital. Clients using the bus must have a caregiver at least 18 years old to accompany them.

Area Bus Will Pick Up: From Englehart, to and including:

- Brethour Township on the east
- Elk Lake on the west
- Sweet's Corner and Thornloe on the south
- South Y

Area Bus Will Travel: From Englehart, to and including:

- Temiskaming Shores
- Kirkland Lake
- Elk Lake
- Brethour Township

Volunteer Drivers: Will be responsible for using the lift and securing wheelchairs. They will not be responsible for clients in any other way.

Caregivers: Must accompany and be responsible for the wheelchair clients, and must be at least 18 years of age.

Charge: There is no charge at this time to use the bus, but donations will be accepted for upkeep costs with thanks.

When to Apply: Applications to use the bus should be made as many days in advance as possible, as it is difficult to get a driver at the last minute. It is on a first come, first served process. Adjustments may have to be made for the time of pick up, with notification ahead of time.
